Pack all clothes in zip-top waterproof bags. Mark all items with Scout's name or initials using a laundry marker.

Bring a **packed lunch**, including beverage, plus **all medications** and **spending money** on the bus. Do not pack those items in the Scout's duffel bag.

Long-sleeved button shirts and long pants are required for Lifesaving merit badge.

The Scoutmaster must be informed of all medications (prescription and over-the-counter) brought to camp.
